Discuss | Moment Maker by Carlos Whittaker

Chapter 6 | Receiving Focus. "We can stare into trust or stare into fear. Read Luke 8:22-25 and Matthew 14:24-31.

- What is your biggest takeaway from these two stories?
- What fears have you overcome after having Christ come into focus?

Chapter 7 | Receiving Insight. "In our society we tend to reserve the special title of Moment Maker for the scholars, preachers, and rock stars. When in reality, that is not who Jesus selected. // I don't care if you are a nurse, teacher, janitor, fast food worker, or CEO of a multimillion dollar company. God has created us all to be Moment Makers (Page 85-86)." Read Matthew 10:1-8.

- Why did Jesus choose ordinary guys?
- Does Jesus call the qualified or qualify the called? Explain.

Chapter 8 | Receiving Faith. “Daddy. When you were singing that last song, I felt so happy. But it was weird. I was happy because I felt Jesus, but it made me cry. Have you ever cried because you were happy? And I’m still crying because I felt Jesus telling me that I need to become a Christian (Page 89).” Read Matthew 19:14 and Matthew 11:25.

- Why does Jesus want us to have faith like children? Share a story when you exercised childlike faith.

Chapter 9 | Receiving Life. “Remember, we are only a whisper away from eternity. Look around. Who haven’t you told about God’s undying love? (Page 98).”

- Share a regret of not telling someone about Christ.
- Who do you need to invite to church this weekend?

Chapter 10 | Receiving Truth. Jesus told his disciples that there would be suffering, but that they could endure it because there was something good on the other side of it (Page 104).” Read John 16:20-22.

- How has the revelation of Christ’s resurrection helped you specifically?
